

## **Part-time Career-Building Job Opportunity**

### **JOB POSITION: Youth Action Hub Researcher**

Openings in both Bridgeport and New Haven, CT

The Institute for Community Research has two immediate part-time job openings (one in Bridgeport and one in New Haven) to work with the Youth Action Hub team on a study on youth homelessness.

#### **Job Summary:**

The position involves conducting outreach to young people who are experiencing homelessness, recruiting those who qualify into a study, and assisting them in taking an online survey as part of the study. The candidate will join the research team of the Youth Action Hub ([www.youthactionhub.org](http://www.youthactionhub.org)) under the overall guidance and supervision of Heather Mosher, PhD. The Institute for Community Research is an independent, non-profit community-based research organization located in Hartford that conducts collaborative research with communities and other partners ([www.incommunityresearch.org](http://www.incommunityresearch.org)).

#### **Required Qualifications:**

- No prior research experience is required. Employees are trained and supervised in conducting ethical research;
- Able to follow strict procedures to protect the confidentiality and rights of study participants;
- Have some recent experience with being a young adult living in a temporary or unstable housing situation. (Unstable housing refers to not having a safe or consistent place to stay and/or having to stay in places temporarily other than your home.);
- Have reliable transportation to get around Bridgeport or New Haven (depending on the position applying to);
- Have a professional work ethic, and work well independently and in a team; and
- Can commit to working a minimum of 6 hours each week.

**Salary:** \$12 per hour
